Rotary Growing around the World

"Rotary's global network of volunteers crossed new borders this spring with the chartering of clubs in Tajikistan and Equatorial Guinea. The two new clubs bring the number of countries with Rotary membership to 168.

The Rotary Club of Dushanbe, Tajikistan, received its charter on 5 April with 36 members. It joined District 2430, which encompasses clubs in Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, and Turkey.

On 16 May, the Rotary Club of Malabo, Equatorial Guinea, officially opened its doors, joining District 9150 in Central Africa."
