B.I.G. Book Sale

The Parole Rotary Books for International Goodwill (B.I.G.) Project will hold its quarterly book sale from 8-2 on Saturday December 10th at 1325 Marlboro Road, Lothian, MD 20711. The B.I.G. project has sent over 1.9 million books to developing countries and over 5000 books to U.S. troops in Iraq and Afghanistan. Plans are being made to send books to school libraries devastated by hurricane Katrina. Profits from this sale will go toward covering upcoming shipments.

Over 30,000 good used books and 1000 records of all kinds will be available. Most books are new since the last sale. Special Pricing: Fill a grocery bag for \$25 or \$1.50 for hardbacks and 50 cents for paperbacks.
